TRANSPORTATION

ACCELERATE BELTLINE DEVELOPMENT, ALONG WITH PATH FOR MOTORIZED TRANSIT; JUDICIOUSLY USE THE T-SPLOST; AND EXPAND MARTA.

When it comes to transportation, "all of the above" is what we need.

Neighborhoods throughout the city feel the impact of congestion daily, as heavy traffic often flows through residential streets not intended for such use.

Specifically, the BeltLine should be completed as quickly as possible, with a path for motorized vehicles. The BeltLine will knit the city together more closely, spur private development because of the infrastructure investment, and revitalize parts of the city suffering from lack of investment. Further, judicious use of the T-SPLOST for automobile-based transportation projects will improve the ability of workers and others to travel around the metropolitan area. Finally, the expansion of MARTA and building of new infill rail stations within the city (connected to BeltLine transportation options), along with new buses, will aid in supplying an "all of the above" option for Atlanta residents for transportation.
